

MEMBERSHIP APPLICATIONS – VISITORS APPOINTMENT PROCEDURE

Quakers in Scotland Co-ordinating Group suggest the following procedure in appointing visitors for membership applications, bearing in mind that not all applications require visitors. This proposal aims to unify slight differences between Scottish area meetings in process.

QiSCG suggests to QiS that it adopts the following procedure:-

Alongside the application, the QiS clerk should receive the suggested name of a visitor from the LM. If there is time, the elders from appropriate LMs would be asked for suggestions for the second visitor. If this can't be done, someone is chosen at the meeting of QiS, possibly subject to consent.

Within this system all or part of the membership process is something that might be delegated to an Intermediate Meeting.
